**CIRCULAR**

**Subject: Child Safety Measures in Schools – reg.**

In continuation of the instructions issued by the Directorate of Education regarding implementation of Child Safety Guidelines ((F.No.DE.40(20)(180)/EVGB/Pt.1/2026/814-822 dated 19.06.2026) and compliance with the provisions of the POCSO Act, 2012, it has been observed that strict vigilance is required to ensure the safety and security of children within school premises.

Accordingly, all Heads of Government Schools are hereby directed to ensure the following:

**1) Restriction of Unauthorised Access:**

No unauthorised person shall be allowed to enter the school premises for any purpose, including maintenance, repairs, construction or any other work, without proper verification and prior written permission of the Head of School. The Visitor Management Protocol as prescribed in the circular dated 19/06/2026 shall be followed meticulously at all times.

**2) Supervision of Visitors and Workers:**

All visitors, contractual staff, maintenance personnel and other persons entering the school premises shall remain under appropriate supervision. Under no circumstances shall they be permitted unrestricted access to students or student activity areas.

**3) Personal Responsibility of the Head of School:**

The Head of School shall be personally responsible for ensuring strict implementation of all child safety measures and security protocols within the school premises. Any lapse compromising the safety and security of students shall be viewed seriously and appropriate action shall be initiated against the concerned officials, as per the applicable rules.

**4) Special School Management Committee (SMC) Meeting:**

All Heads of Schools shall convene a Special Meeting of the School Management Committee (SMC) at the earliest to review and assess the physical infrastructure of the school from the perspective of child safety and security. The SMC shall identify any safety gaps or vulnerabilities and recommend appropriate corrective measures. The Head of School shall ensure

that all identified deficiencies are addressed on priority to provide a safe and secure learning environment for all students.

**5). Strict Compliance:**

All Heads of Schools shall disseminate these instructions among the concerned staff and ensure their strict compliance in letter and spirit.
